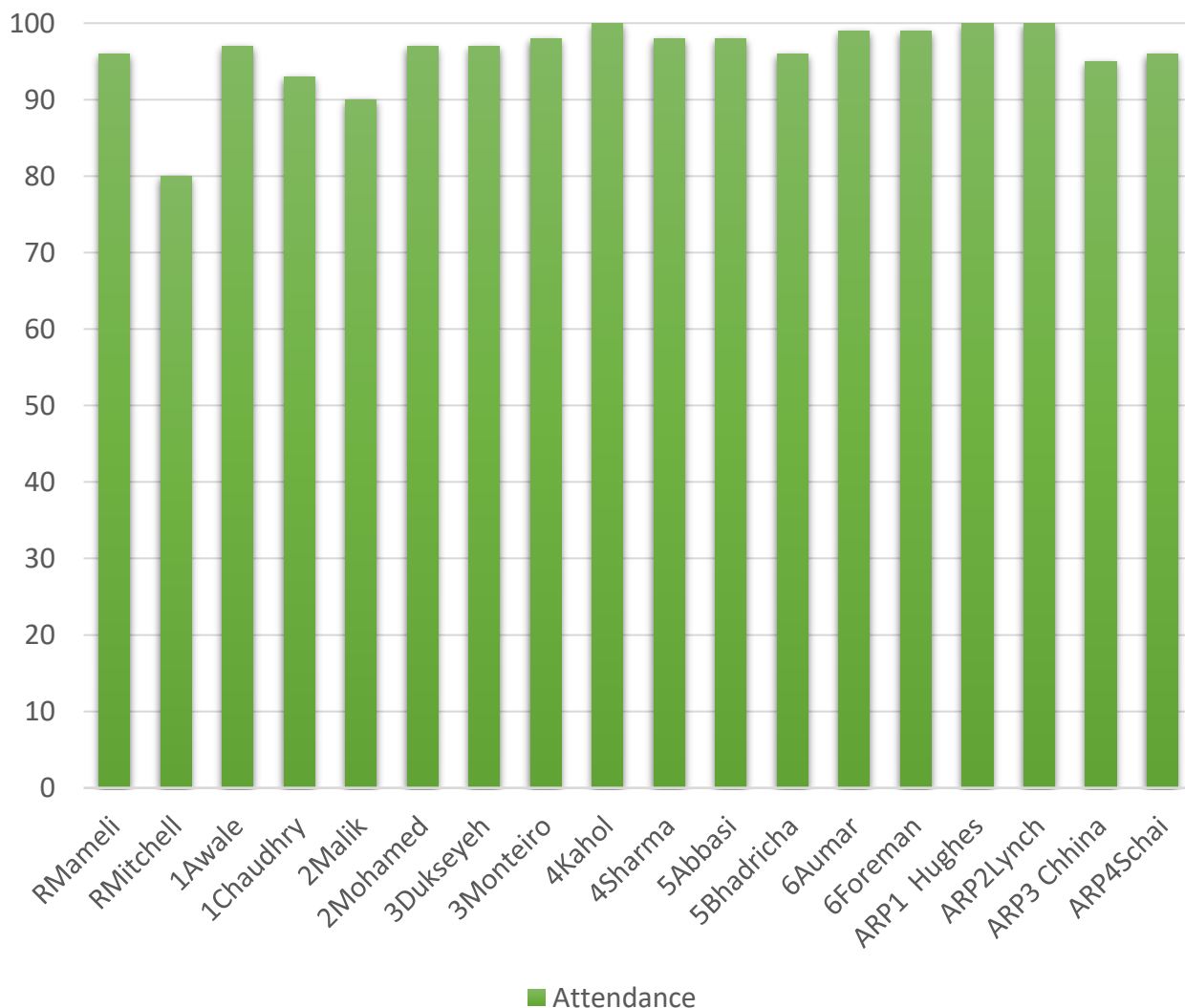


Attendance at Havelock

Careers Week

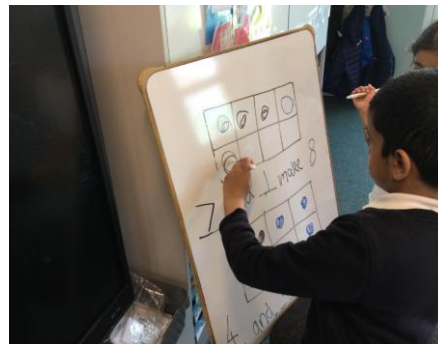

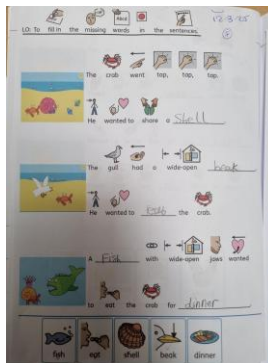
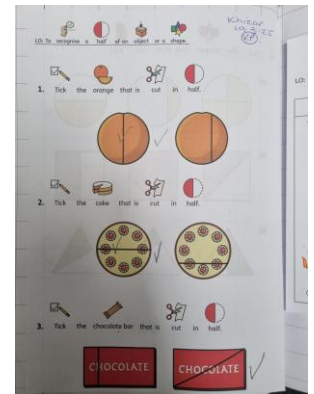

ARP 1 have been looking at ways 8 can be partitioned using an eight frame. The children worked in pairs to complete the eight frame based on the completed stem sentence.



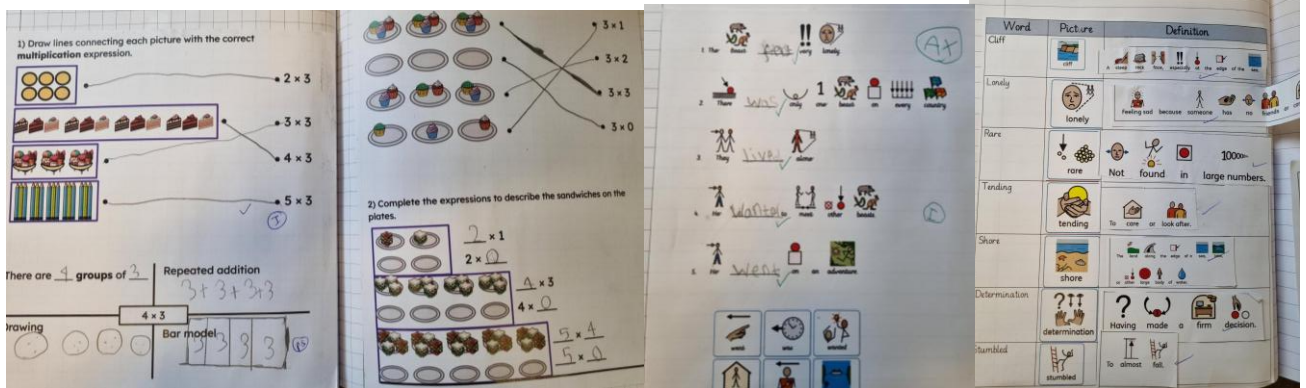
ARP 2 have been completing sentences related to their book in English. They have been recognising halves in pictures and real-life objects and sharing items into groups to link to division.

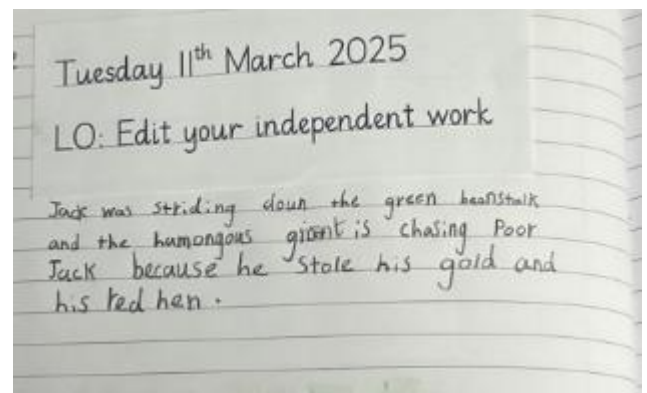
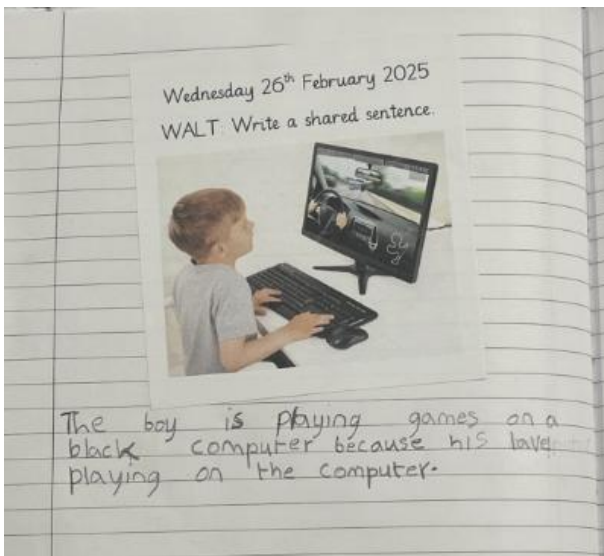
In maths, they have learnt about measurement and made estimations before using tools to measure items. They have answered comprehension questions in English.

English at Havelock Year 1

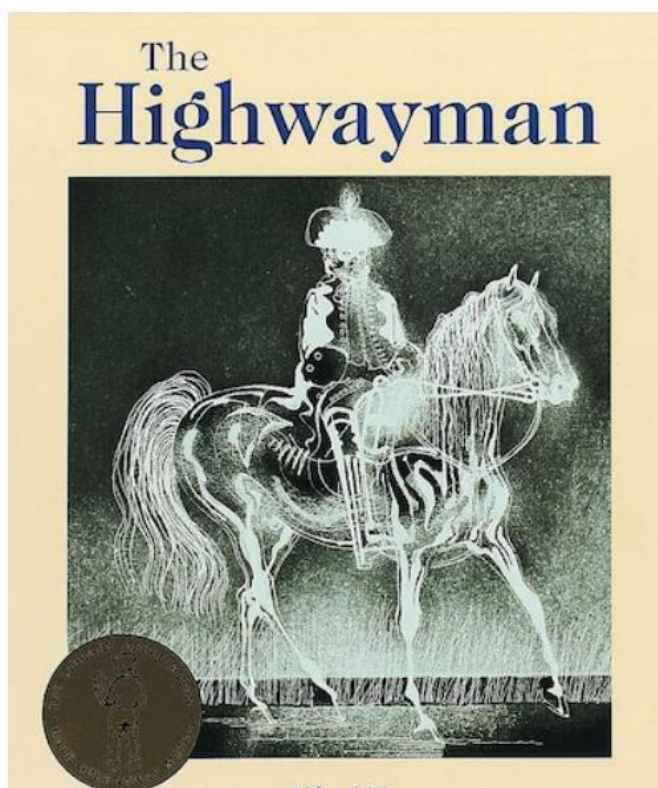
In English, we have been focusing on our storybook *Jack and the Beanstalk*. We have used colorful semantics (who, what doing, what, and where) to describe the story. We completed an independent write about *Jack and the Beanstalk* and a shared write based on a picture of a boy using his computer. Our focus has been on using capital letters, full stops, adjectives, and the conjunction 'because'.

English at Havelock Year 5

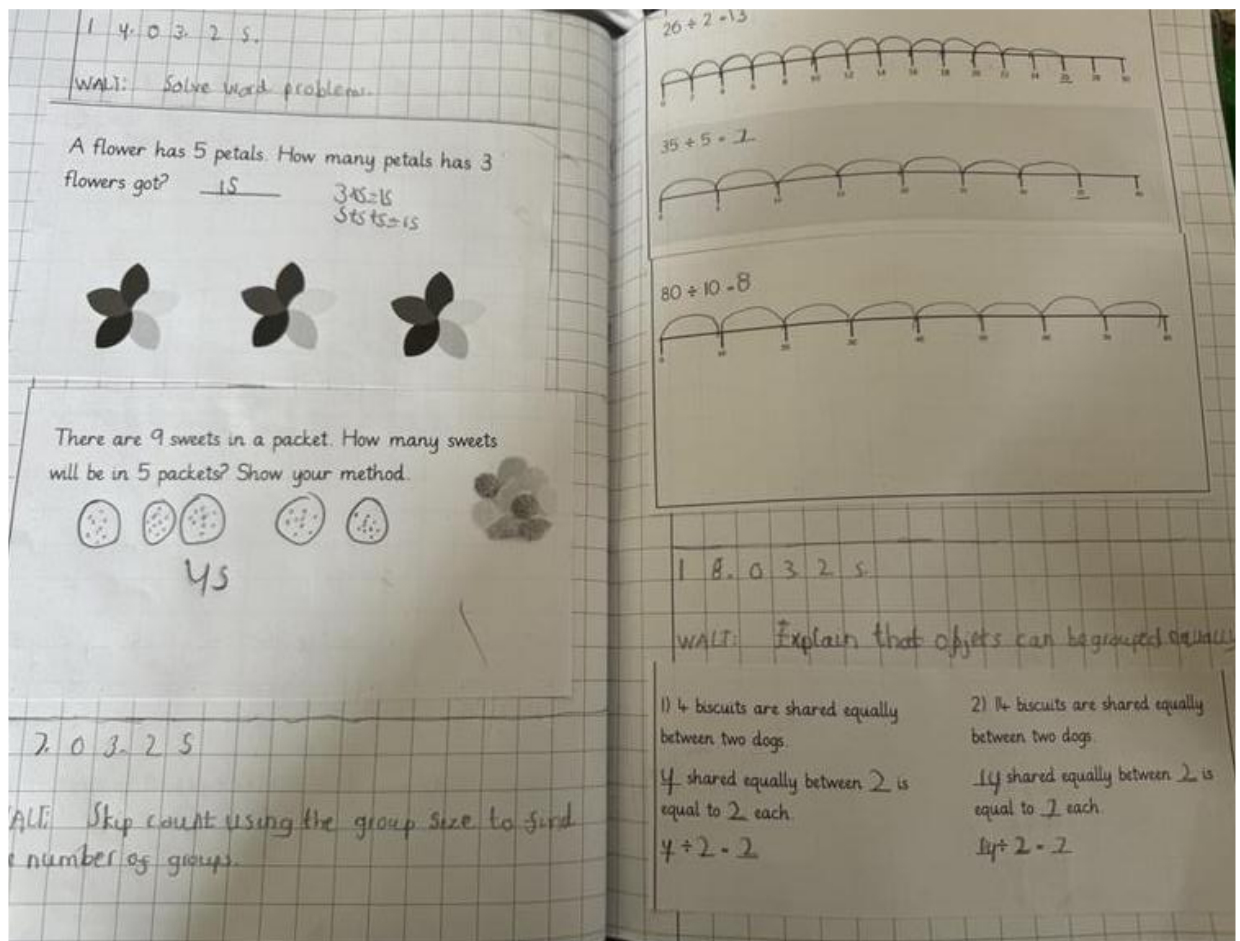

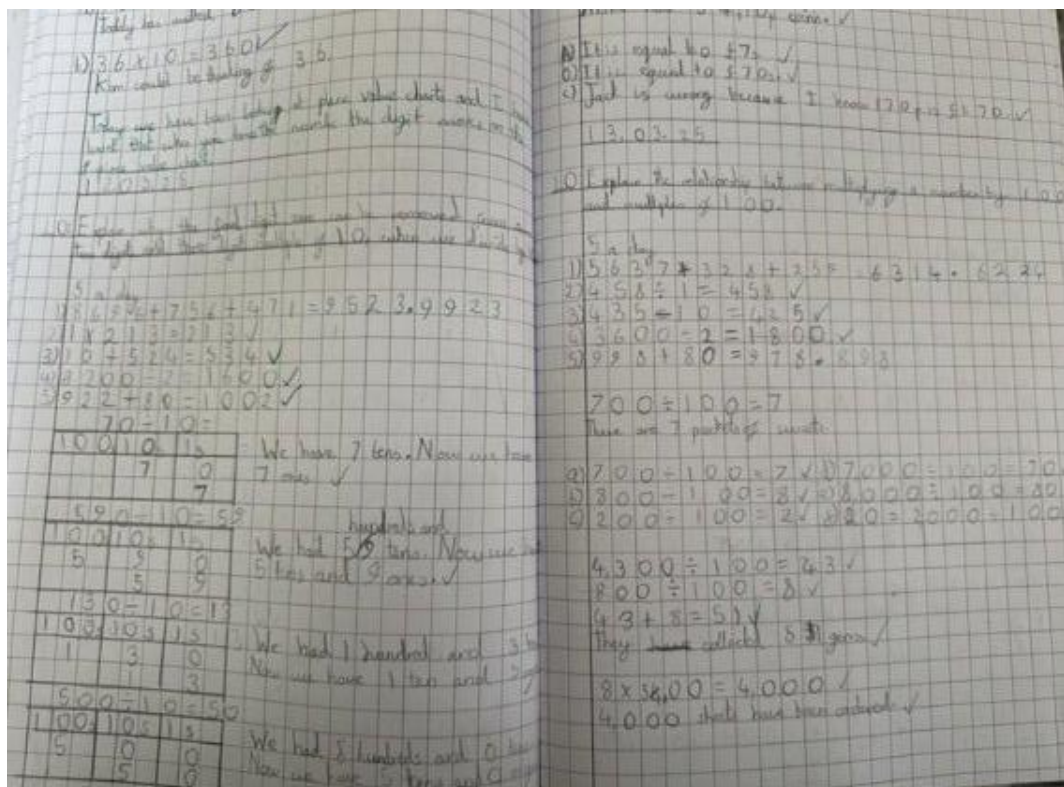

In Year 4, students have been learning about the use of placeholders when multiplying numbers by 10 and 100.

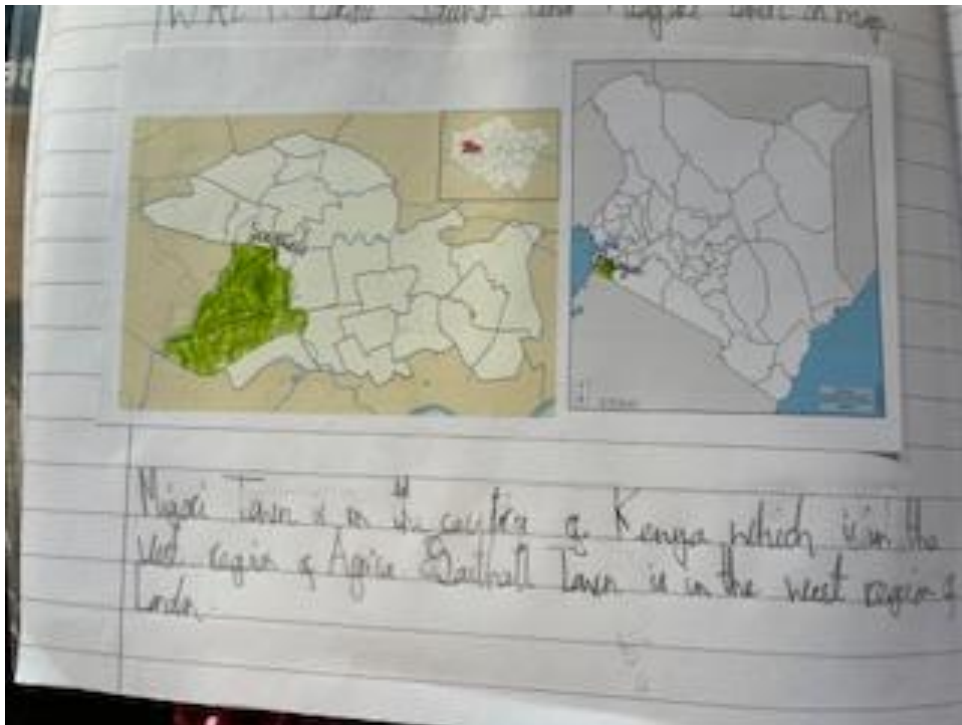
They have also explored the composition of 100, using different strategies to multiply and divide. This has helped them develop a deeper understanding of mathematical structures
