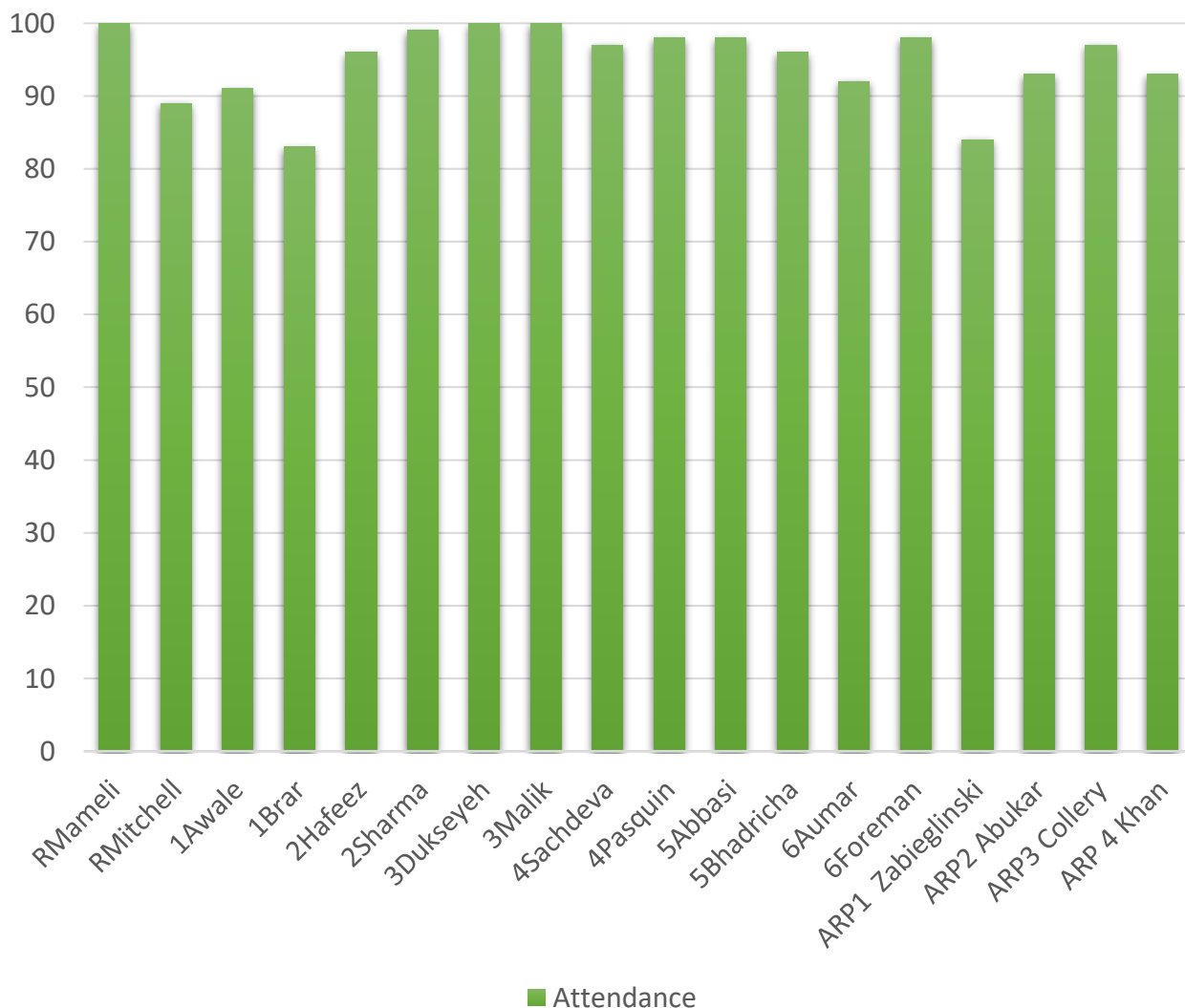
Attendance at Havelock

150 million people could be lifted out of hunger if female farmers had equal **resources**

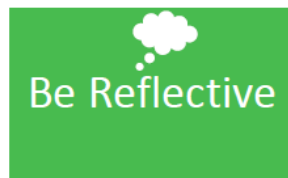
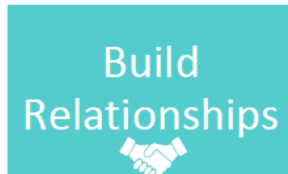
Reflection

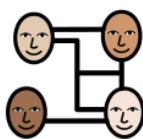

ARP 1

ARP 1 have continued learning about dinosaurs. They looked at examples of fossils and discussed what dinosaurs fossils are. They used playdough to create their own fossils.



ARP 2

ARP 3

This week, ARP 3 have continued to learn about measures in maths. They have been converting between mm, cm as well as g and kg. They have also been measuring and comparing the weight of different objects. In English we have started a new text called Tiddler.

In English, ARP 4 have still been learning about the story Gregory Cool. They discussed what a thought bubble is and wrote in role as the different characters from the story.

This week, reception have been busy planting and learning about how plants grow.

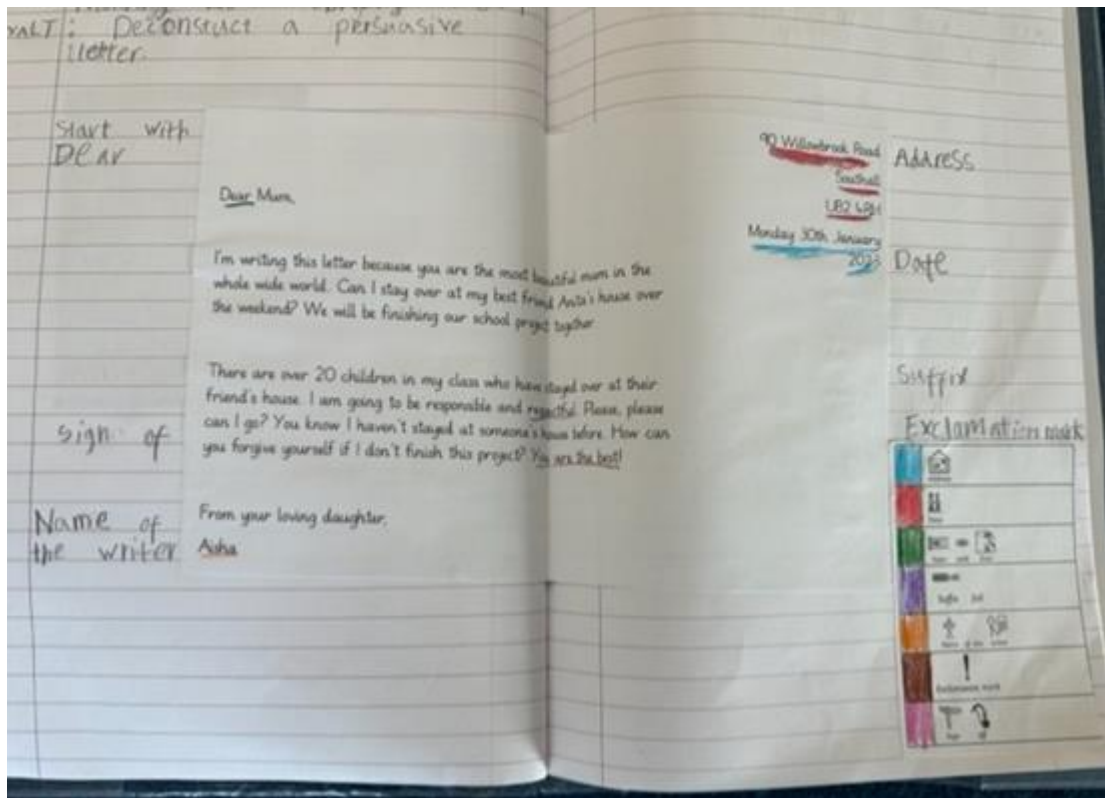

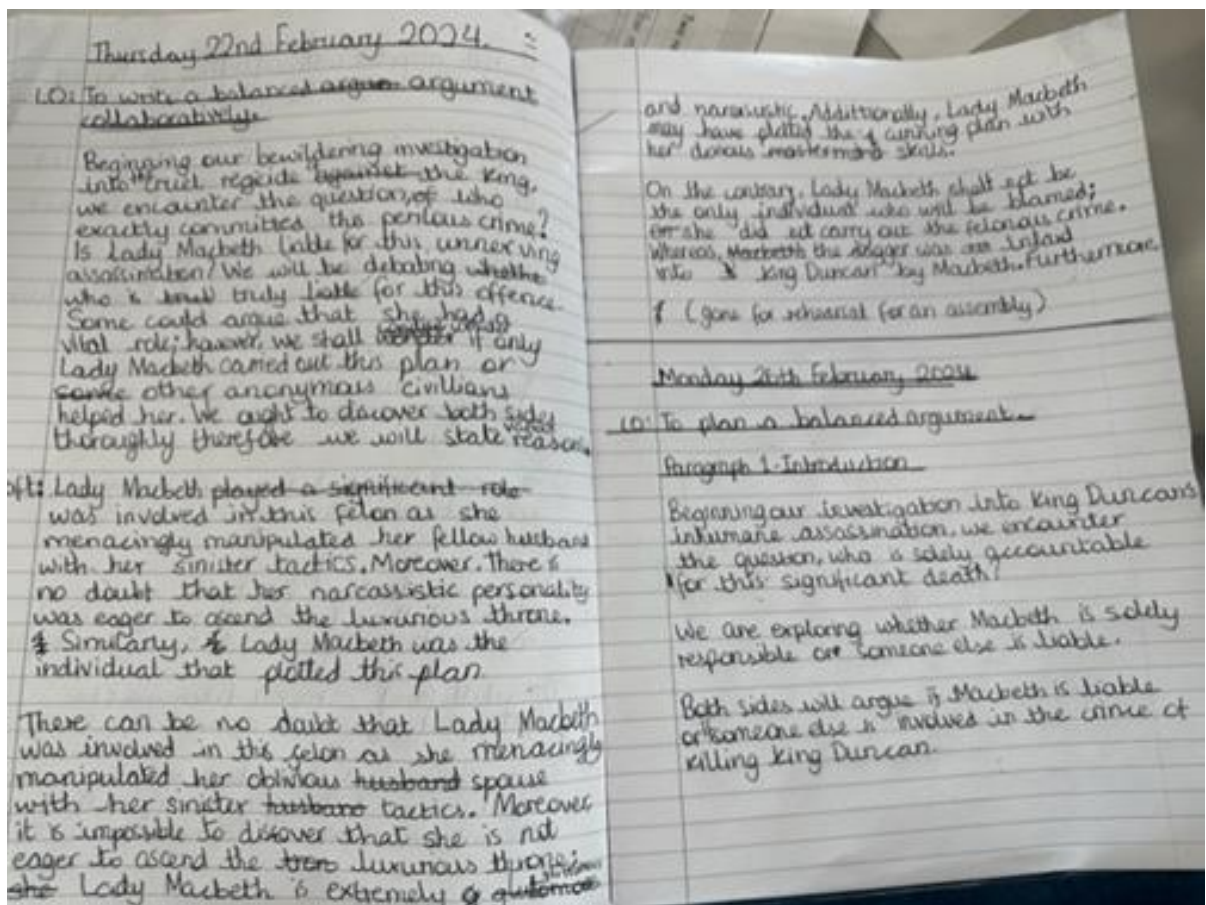

English at Havelock Year 6

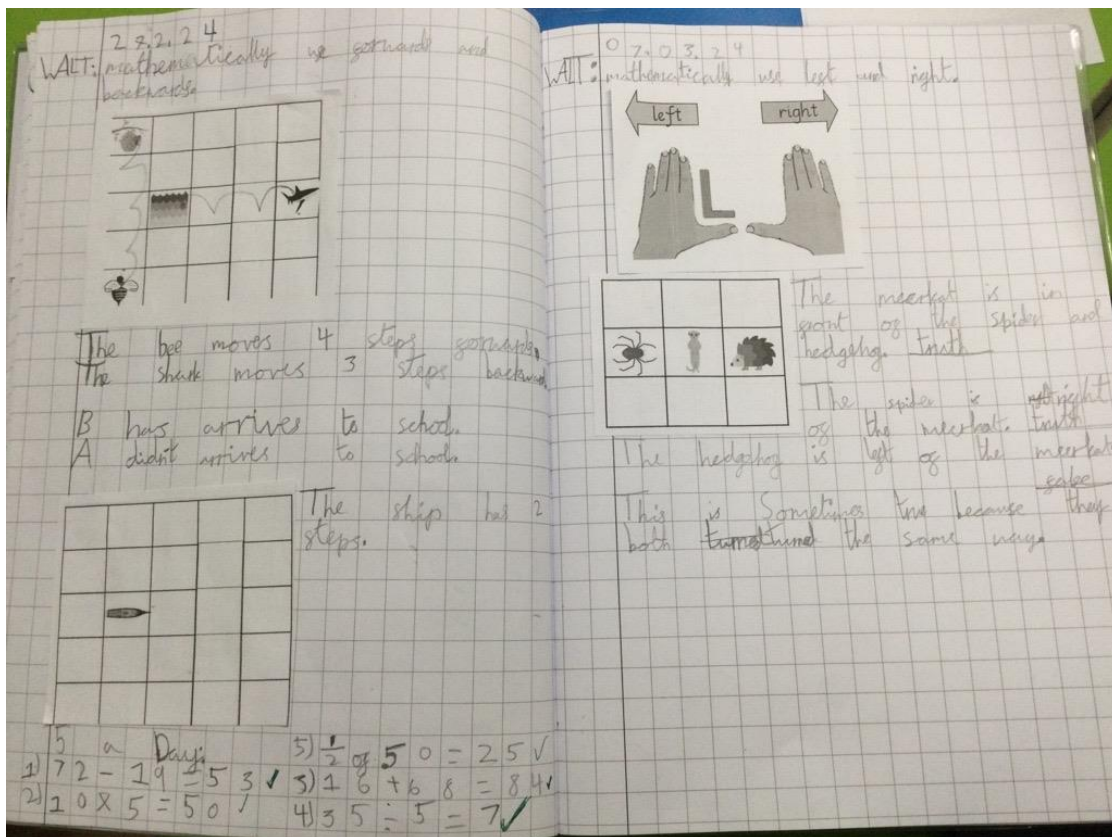

Maths at Havelock Year 2

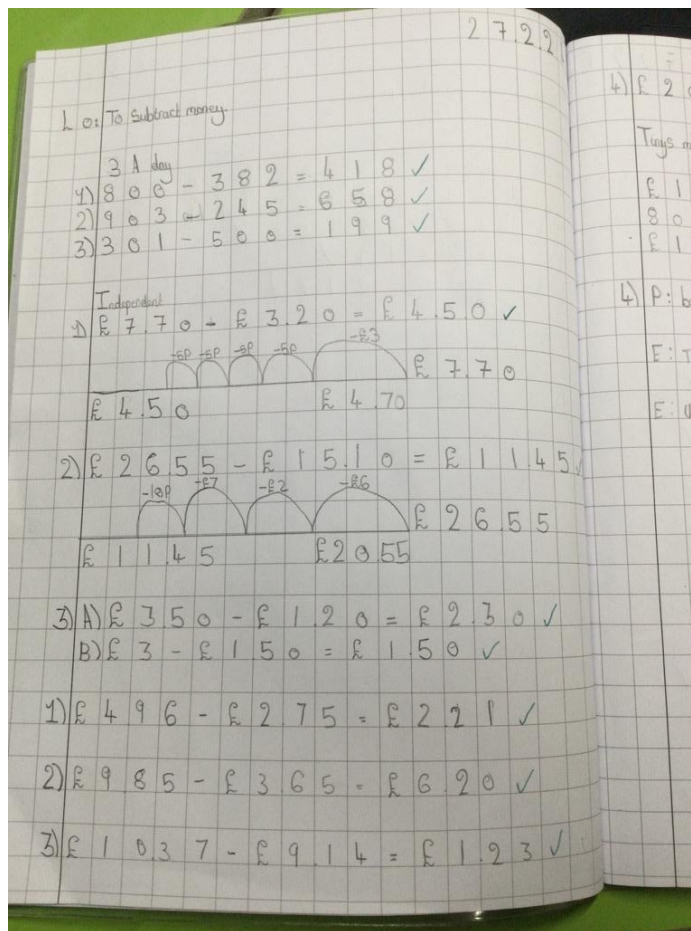
Year 2 pupils have been applying the language: forwards, backwards, left and right in different contexts, honing on their spatial awareness and critical thinking skills.

Spanish at Havelock Year 3

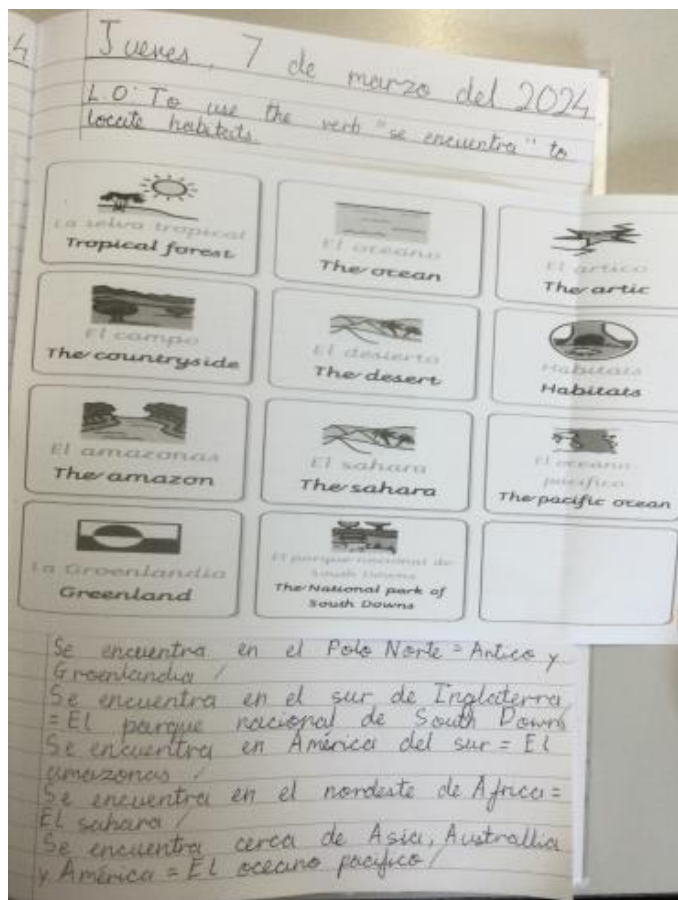

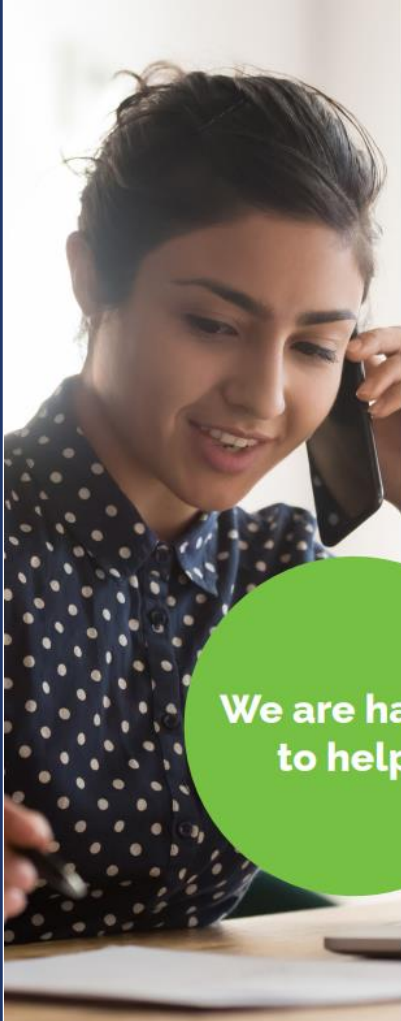
