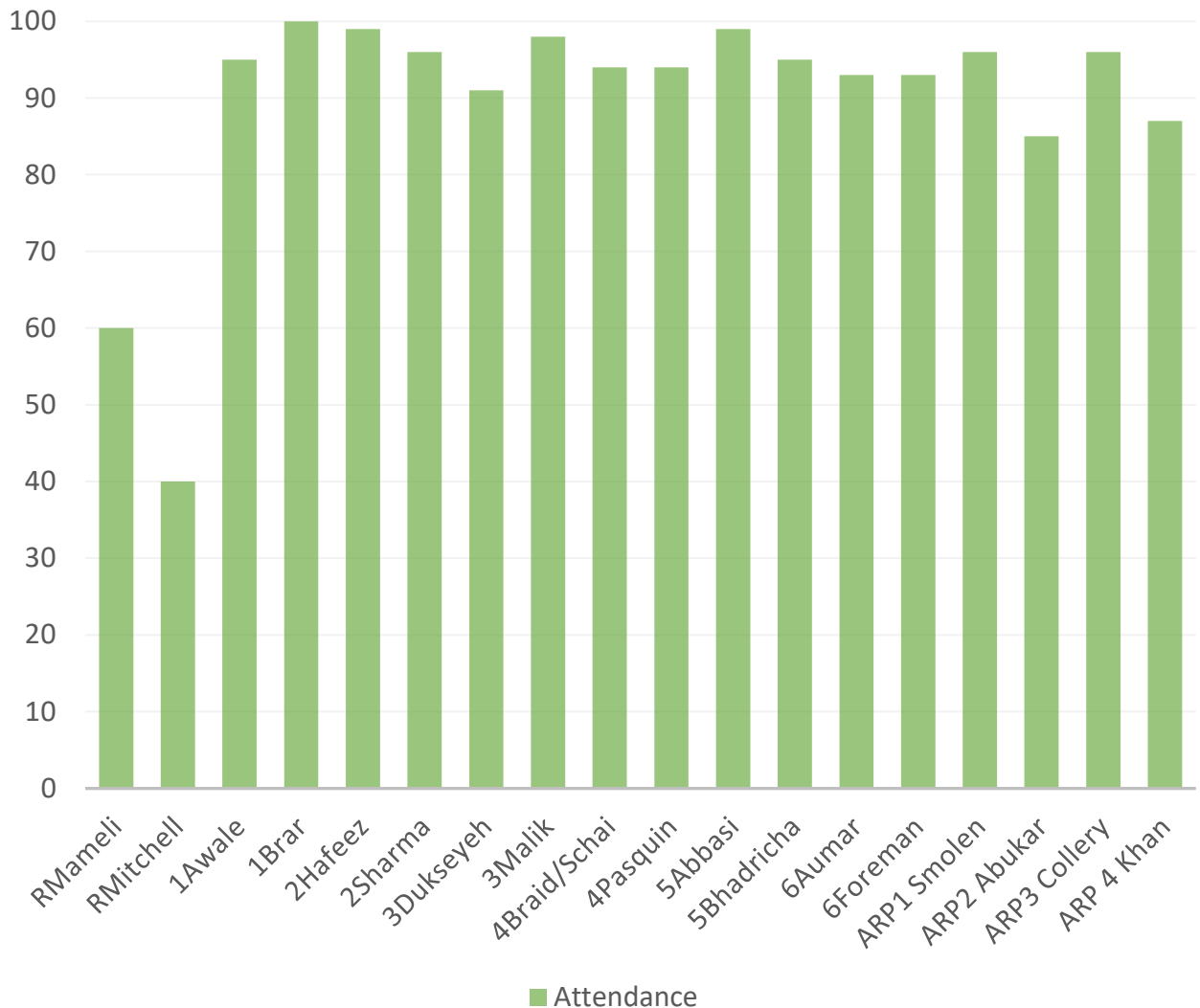
## Attendance at Havelock

- What more can you do to help other people around you to enjoy this right?

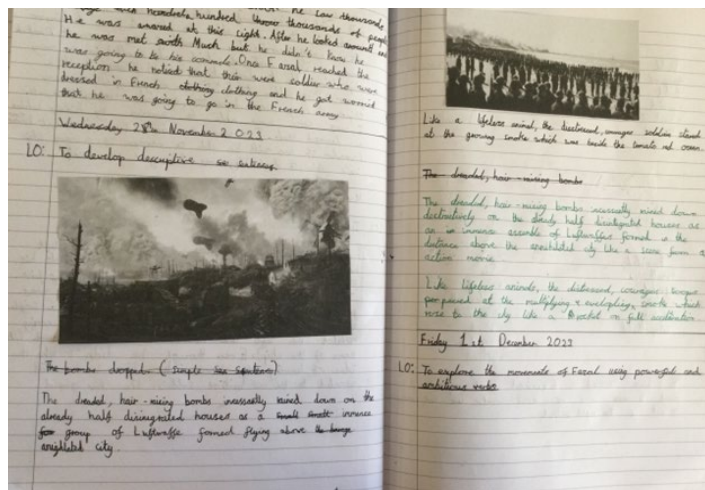

Hello from Havelock's Digital leaders. Today, we will explain what learning has taken place in Year 4, 5 and 6.

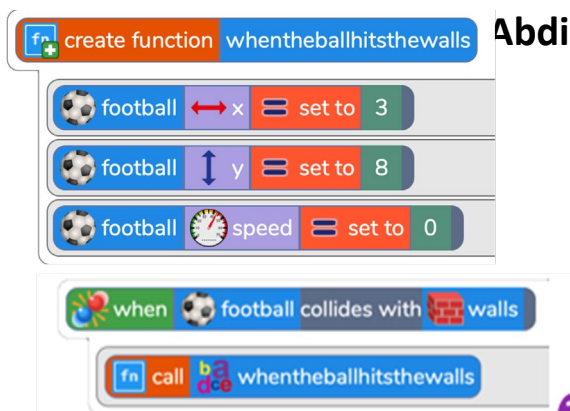
Year 4 have been learning how to code. Last week we made our objects move and talk by programming the correct code and changed the background.

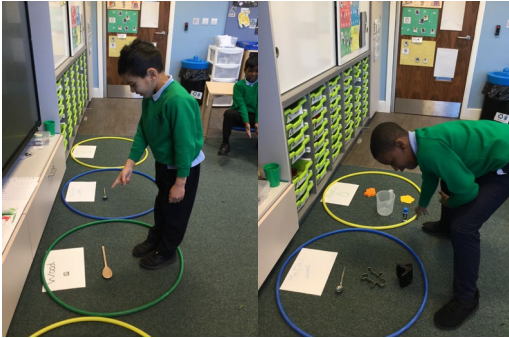

This week, ARP 3 developed their directional vocabulary in maths. In art, they were inspired by their English text the Gruffalo's Child.



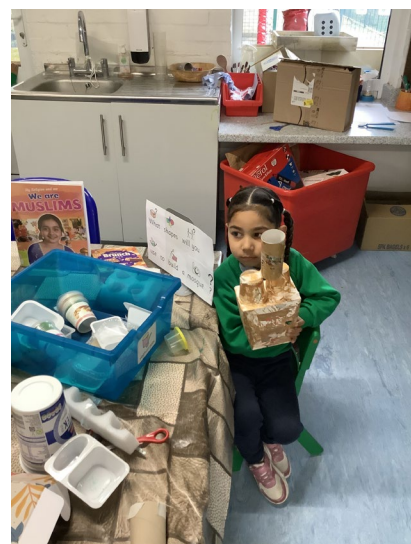
### ARP 4

Nursery children have been learning about 'special times' and the festival 'Eid'. The children have been using their personal experiences and talking about how they celebrate and who they celebrate with.

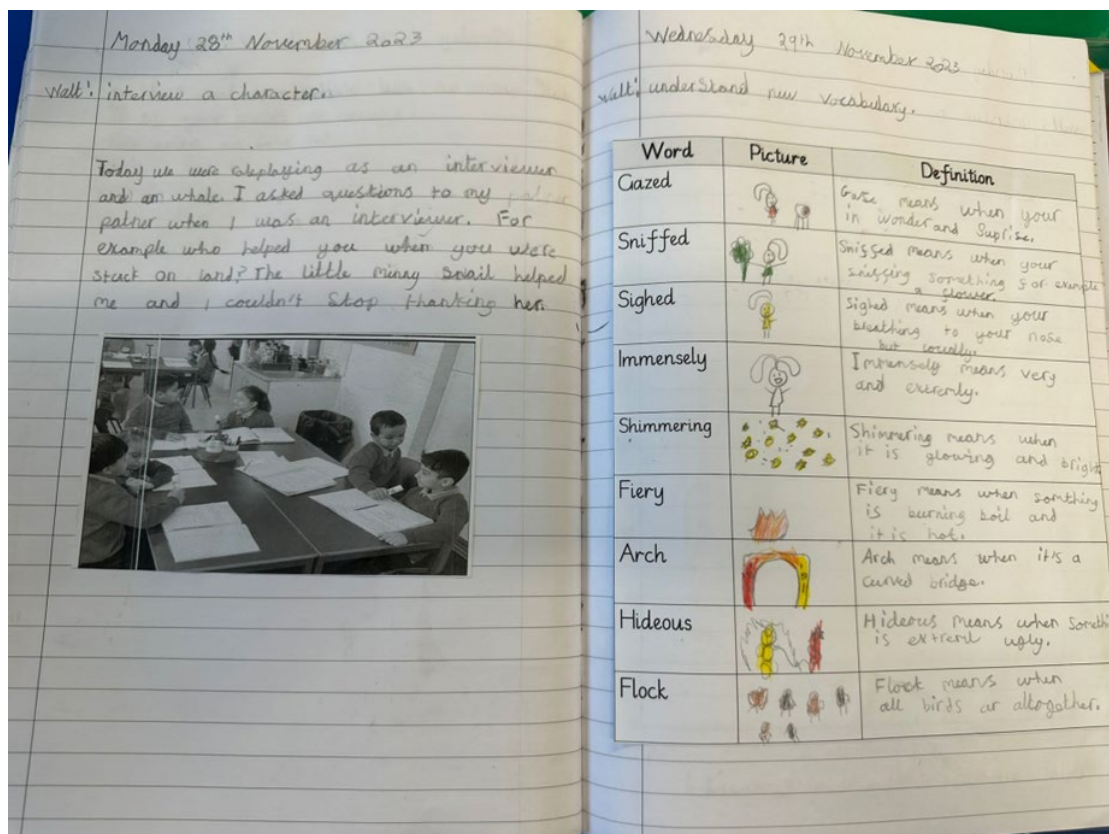


The children have been building their own Mosques and talking about the shapes they use. They have been describing what they have made. The children enjoyed painting and decorating their Mosques independently.

## English at Havelock Year 2

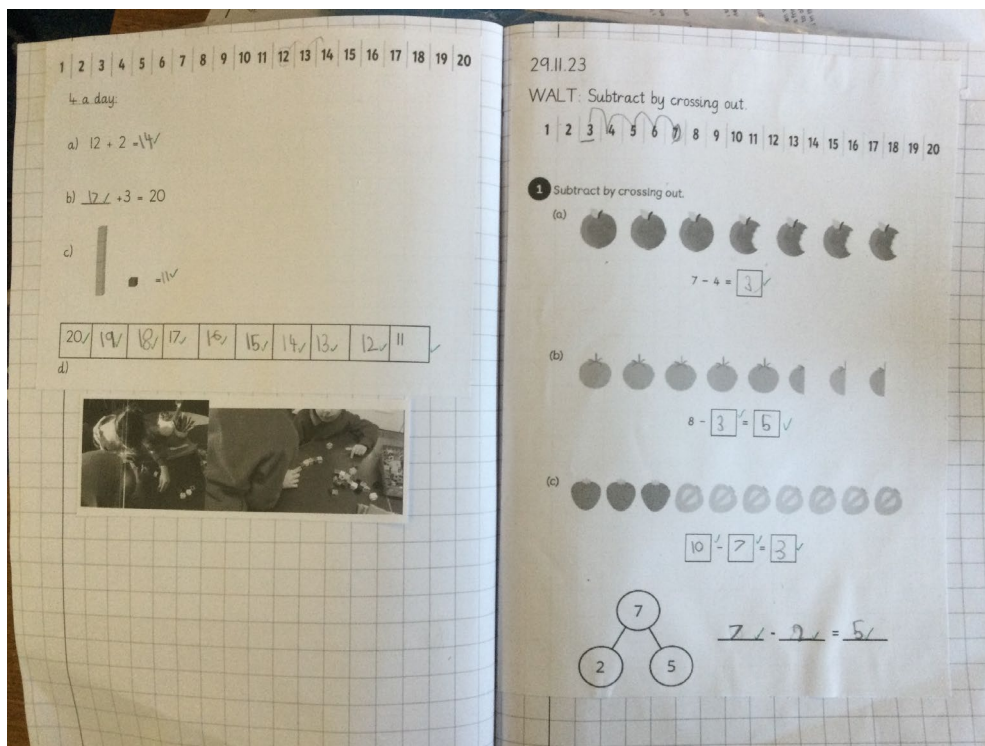

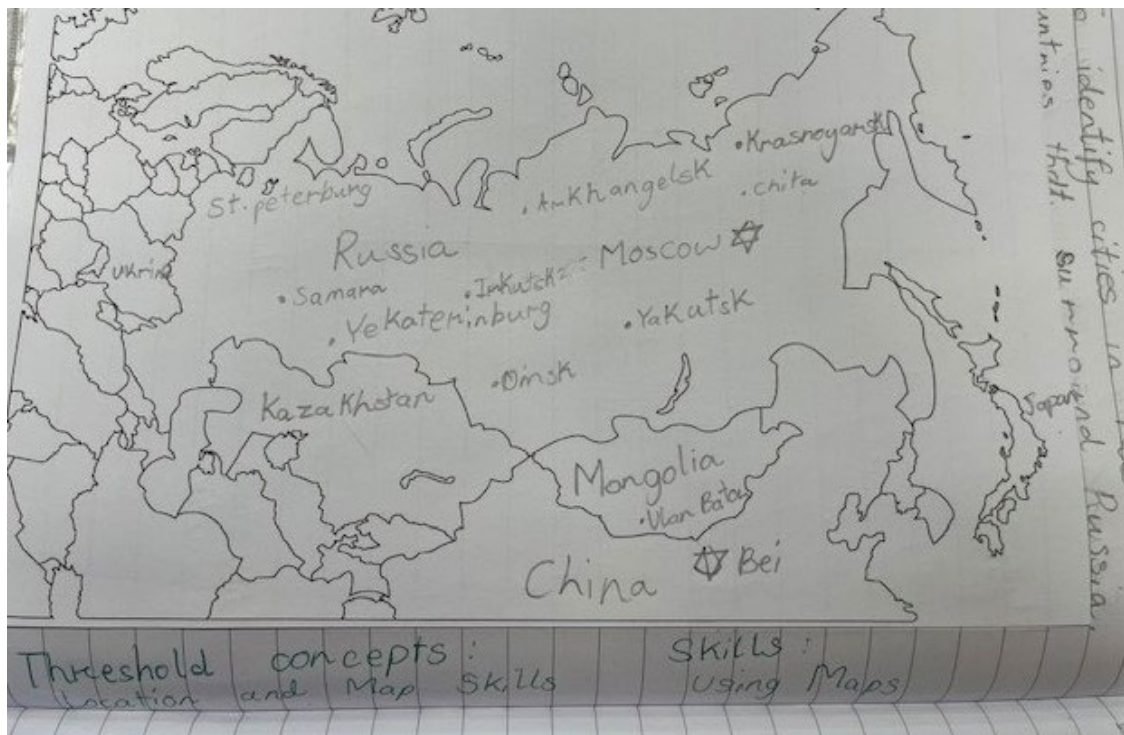
## English at Havelock Year 6

This week the children have started their new unit for English - a recount. They have recalled that the purpose of a recount is to retell events and have also considered the features associated with a recount such as chronological order, expanded noun phrases and powerful verbs.



## Geography at Havelock Year 3

Year 3 have been learning about Europe in their Geography lessons this term. They have used atlases to locate countries in Europe, with a focus on Russia. They have also looked at human and physical features of Moscow and London.

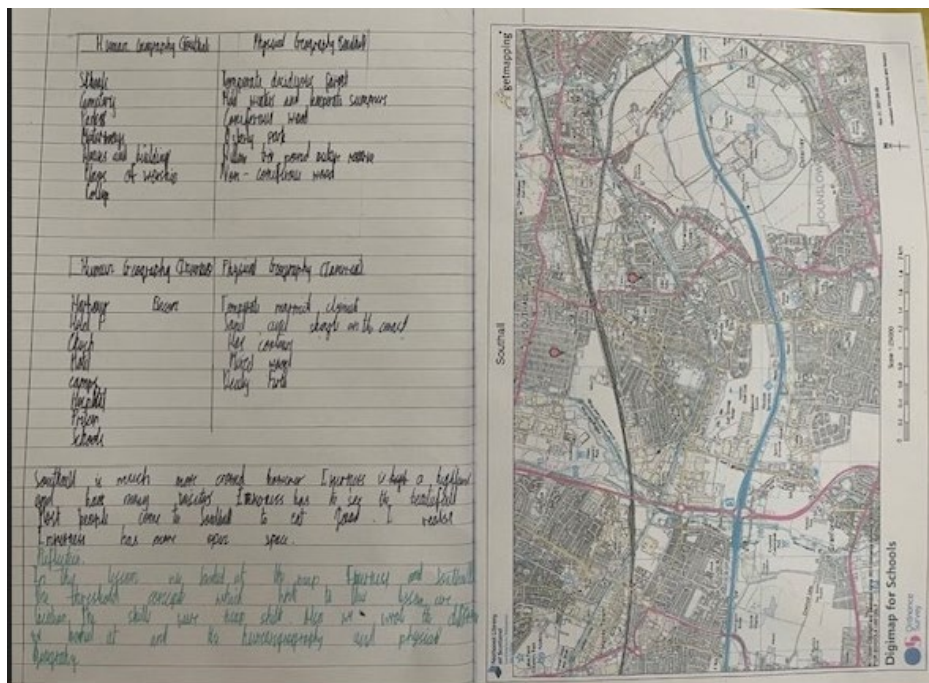

## Class Assembly Year 1Brar

This week was 1Brar's class assembly.

The children explained the importance of phonics and demonstrated parts of a phonics lesson. Phonics is important as it teaches children how to read and write.

They also shared their Maths learning. They learnt number bonds to 10 and 20. They visually represented number bonds to 10 with their bodies.

They ended their assembly by performing a song they learnt in Music: Head, shoulders, knees and toes. They did brilliant actions to the song!

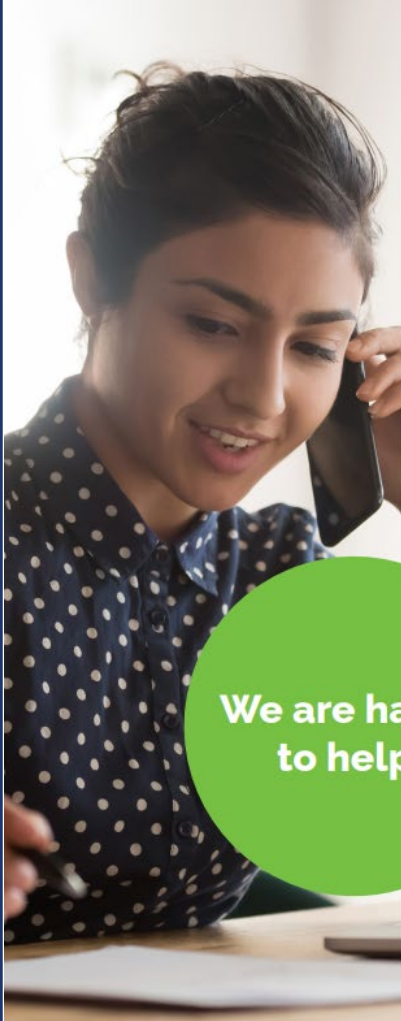
