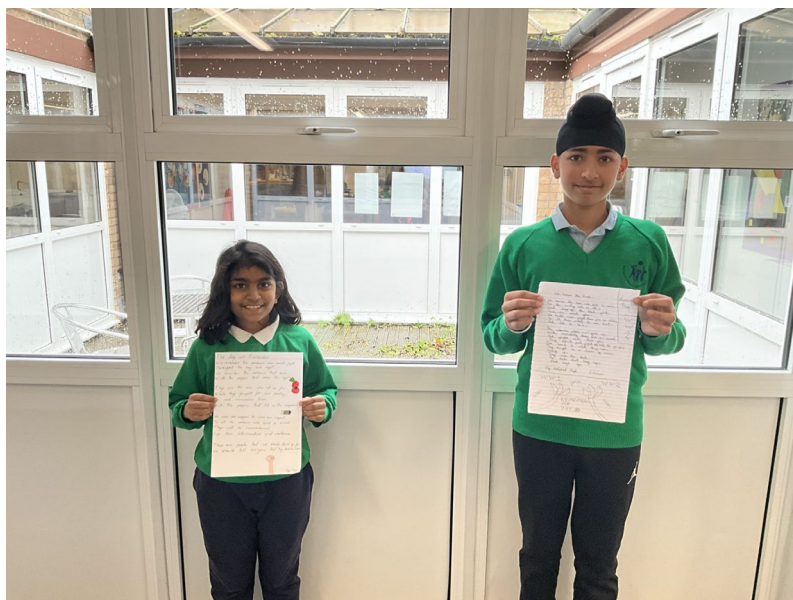


Remembrance Day

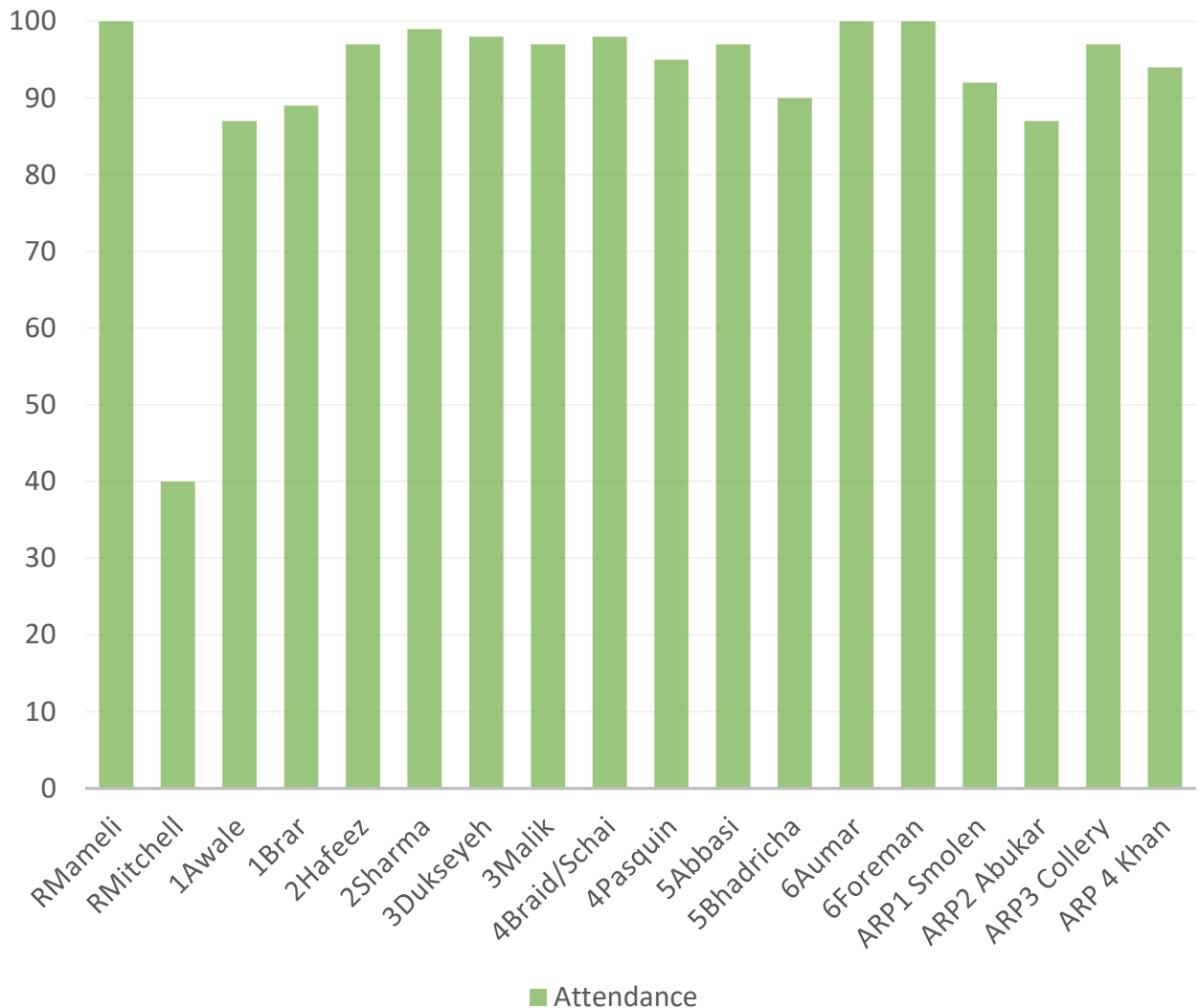
Attendance at Havelock

Article of the week: 38 Protection in war



Governments must not allow children under the age of 15 to take part in war or join the armed forces. Governments must do everything they can to protect and care for children affected by war and armed conflicts.

UNICEF was created in 1946 to help protect and support children after World War II. UNICEF has a long history supporting children, including those affected by wars, ever since.

Reflection:

- Do you have a safe, quiet space in your school/ at home to help you reflect and think?
- Think about where this is and how it makes you feel- many children do not have this safe space.
- Use this space to consider those who have lost their lives in war and those that are currently experiencing the suffering of war.
- Reflect on how these people's sacrifice has supported you to access your rights

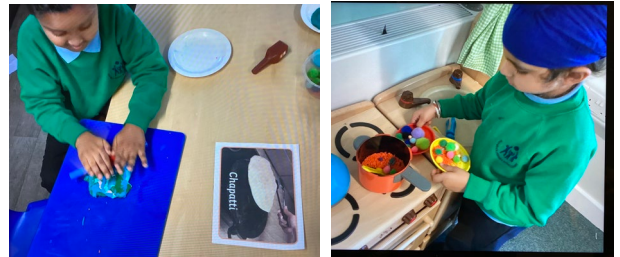

This week ARP4 have continued learning about the story Jabari Jumps. They learnt about commands to help them write an instruction text about diving. They practiced this during their swimming lesson.

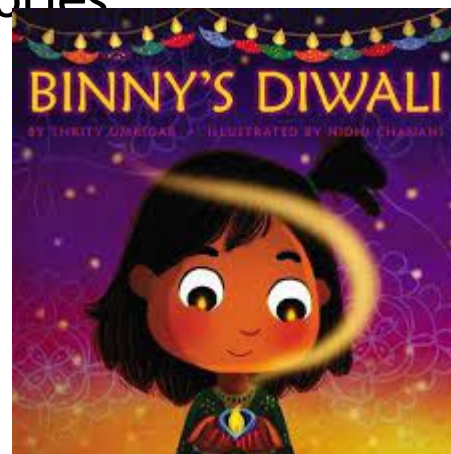

EYFS - Nursery

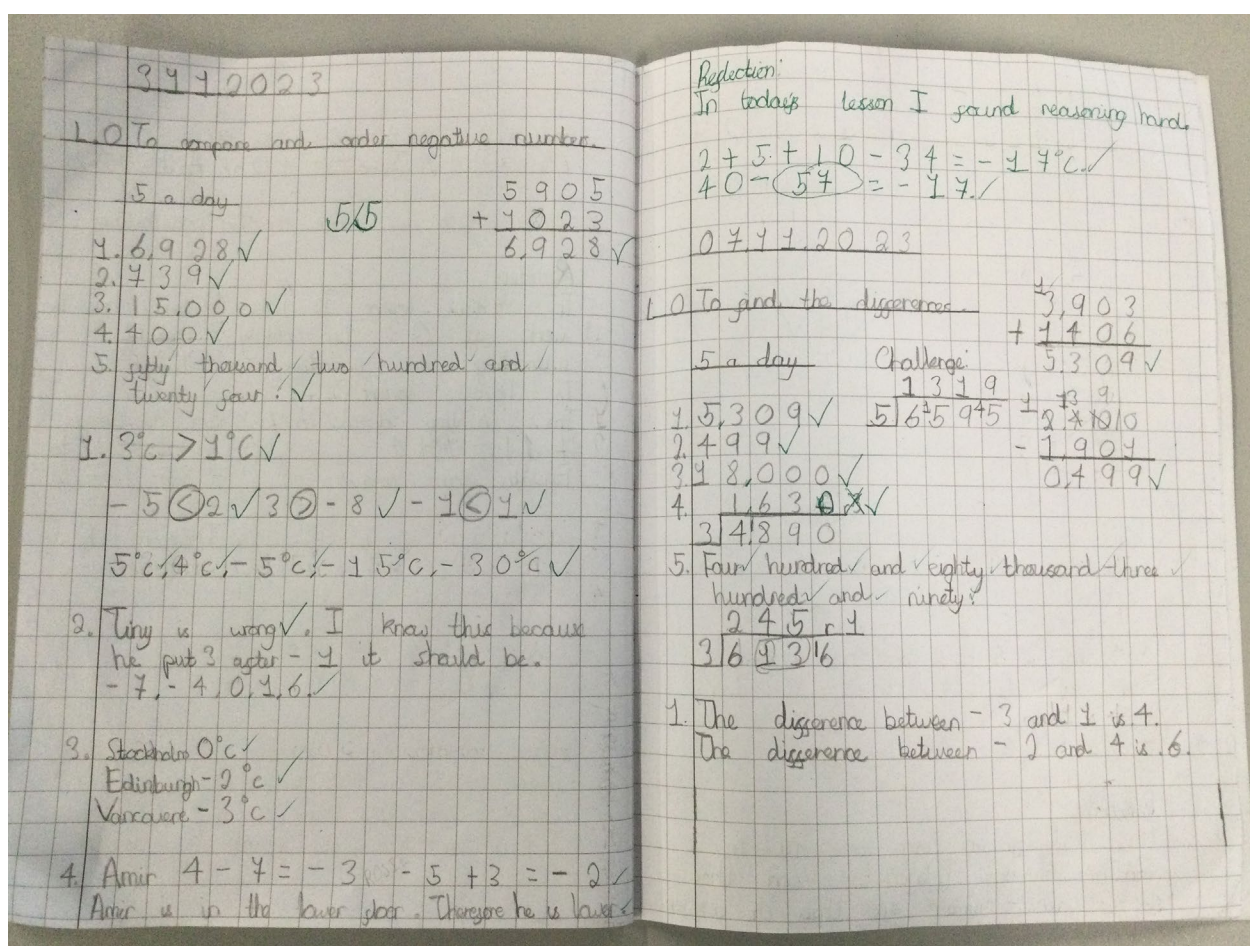

Maths at Havelock Year 5

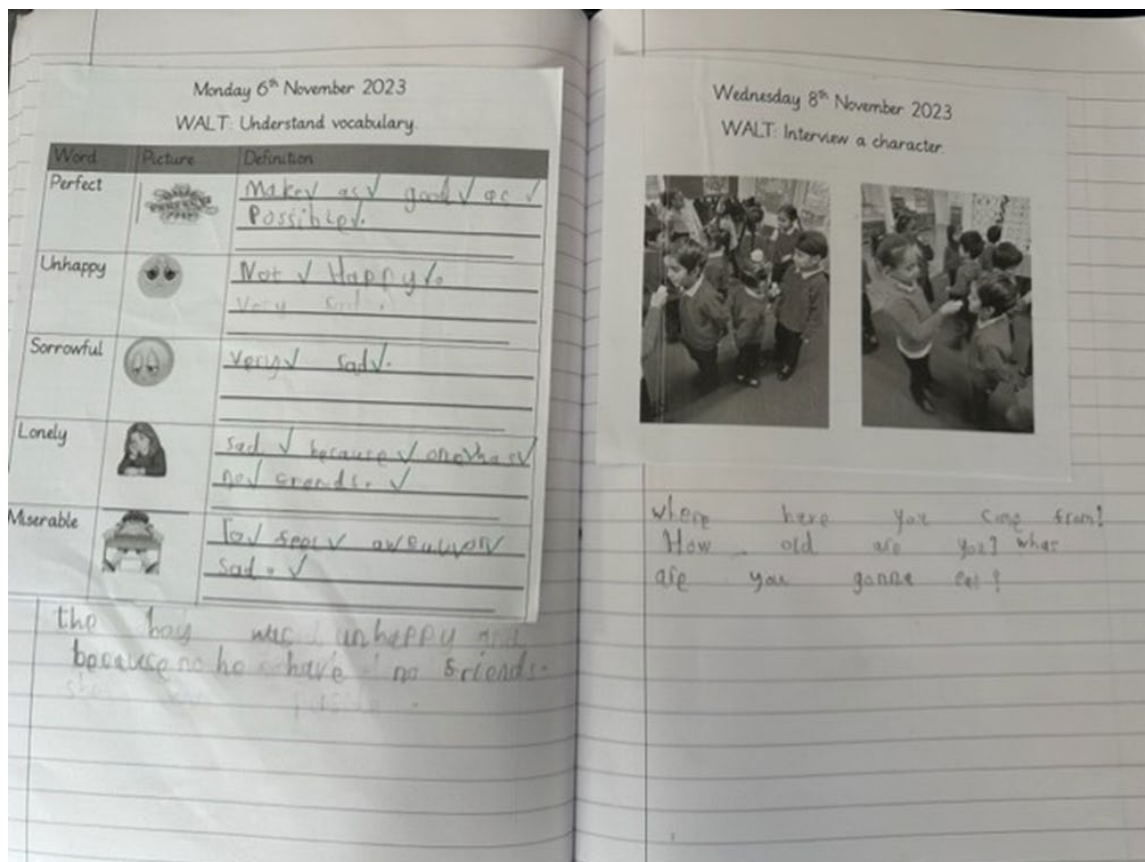
This week in maths, pupils have been exploring negative numbers. The class discussed misconceptions they may have in order to help them order and compare fractions.

English at Havelock Year 1

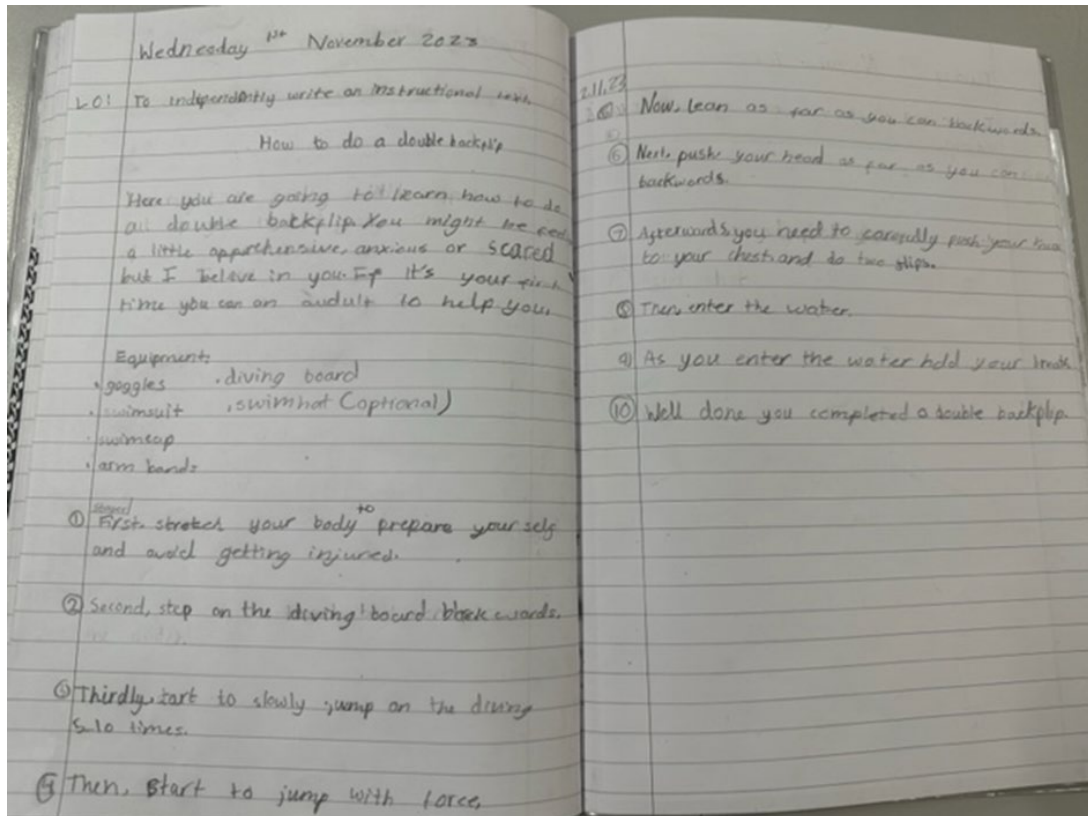
Year 1 started their new book called Beegu. They made predictions from the front cover, learnt new vocabulary and did a character interview. They acted in role as the character and answered questions.

English at Havelock Year 3

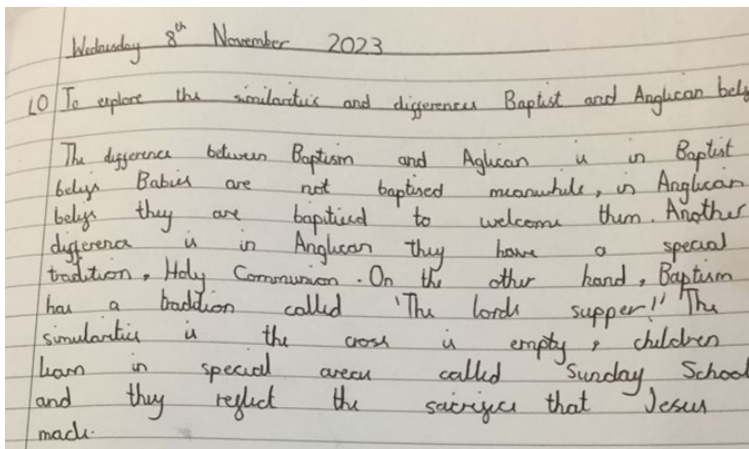
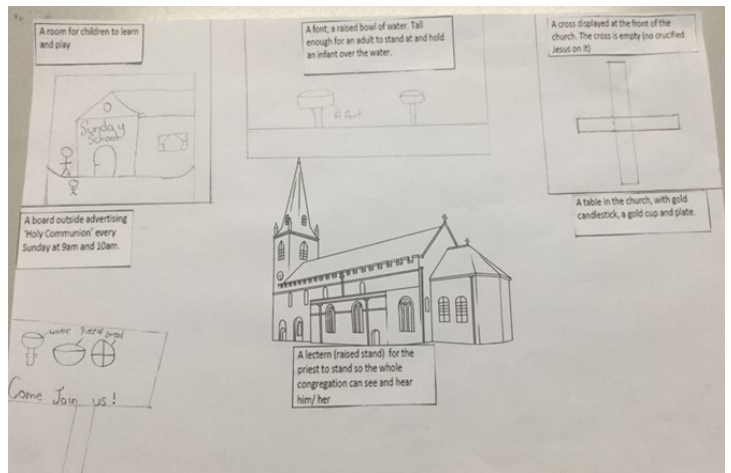

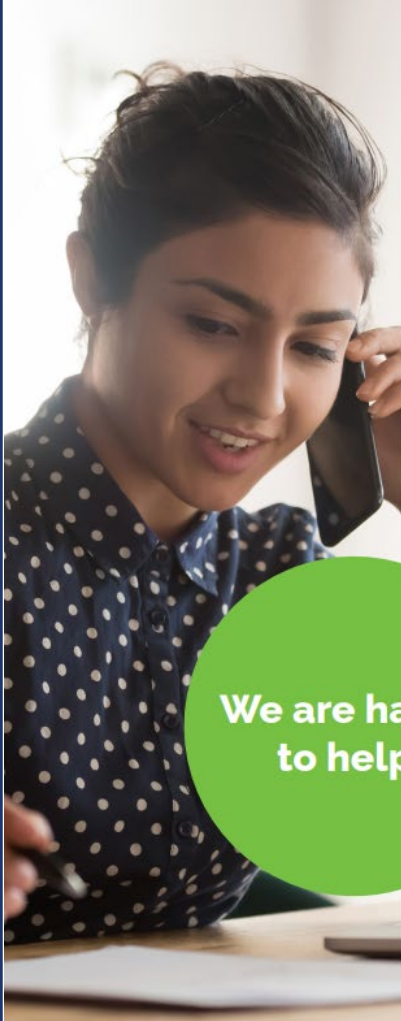
