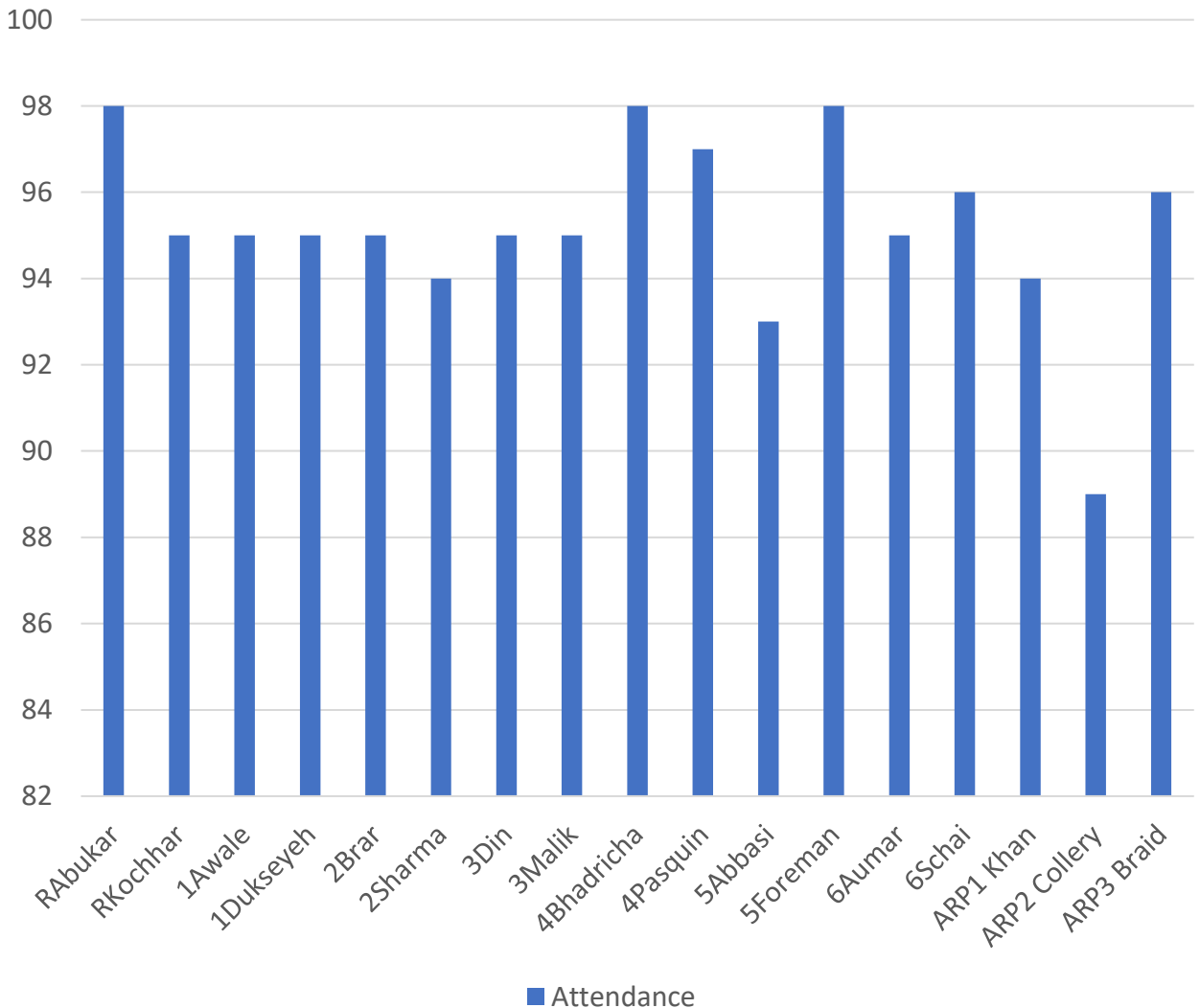
Attendance at Havelock

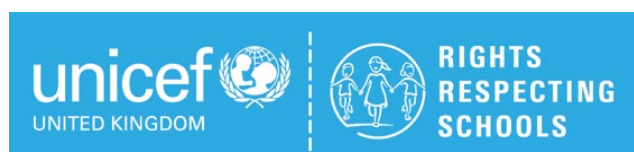


Article 31 says: Every child has the right to relax, play and take part in a wide range of cultural and artistic activities.
