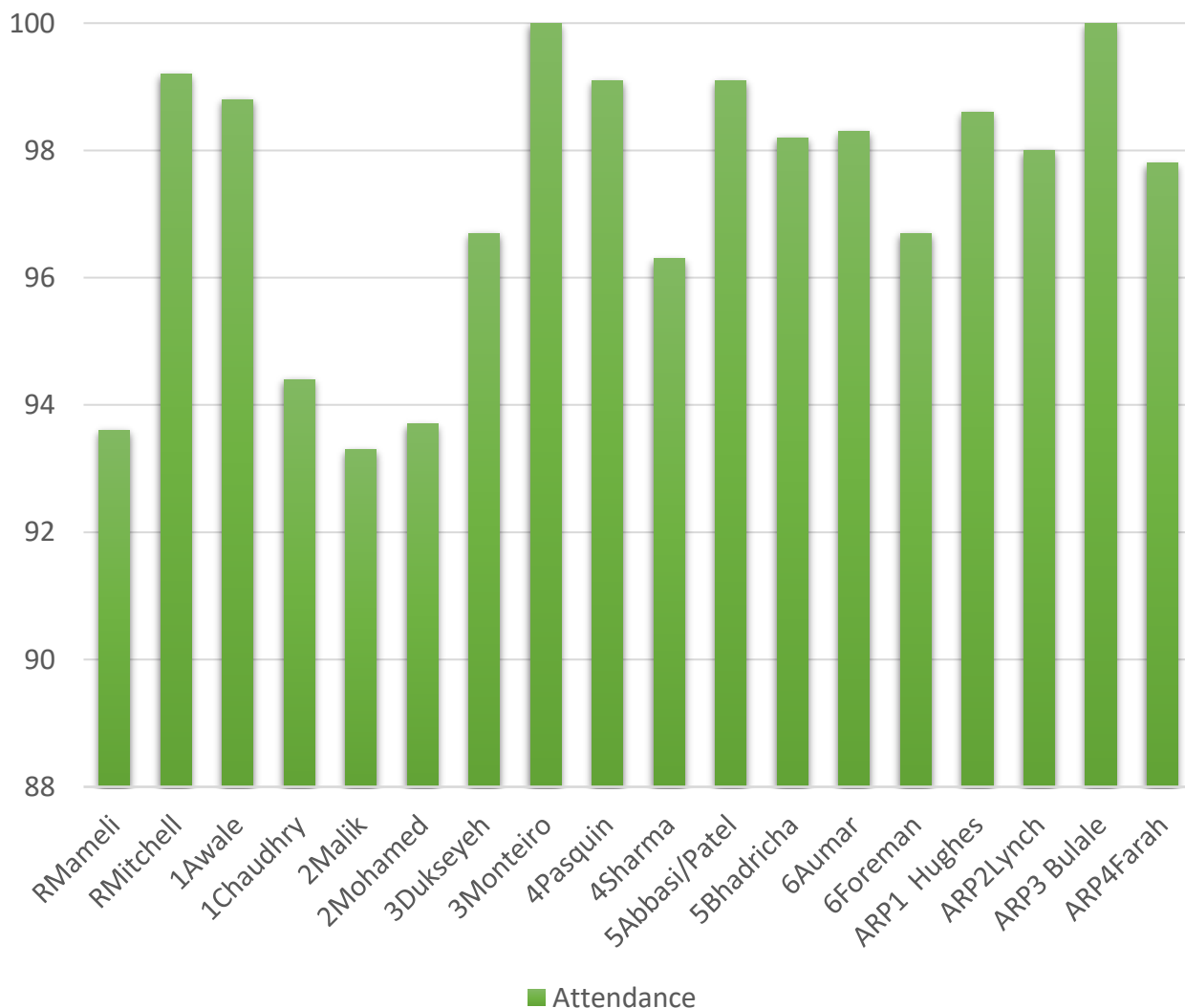
## 2025 - 2026 Attendance at Havelock

The little explorers have been incredible at using their exploration skills to correctly name and identify a range of animals that live under the sea.



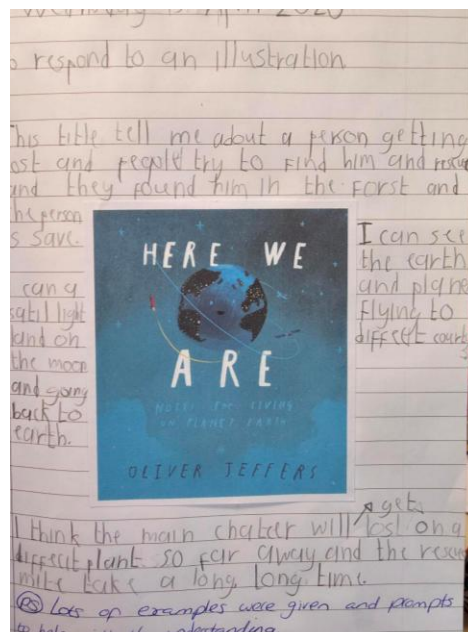
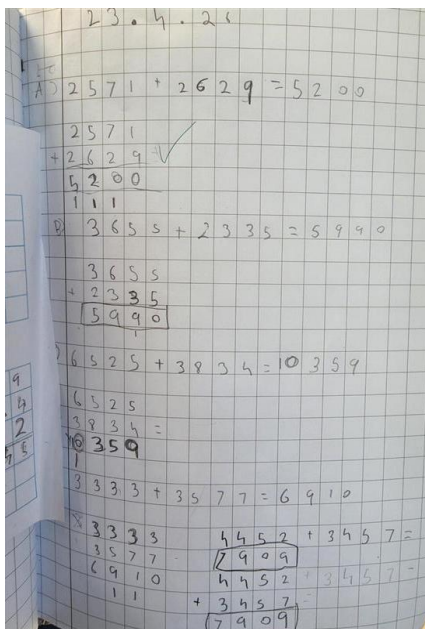
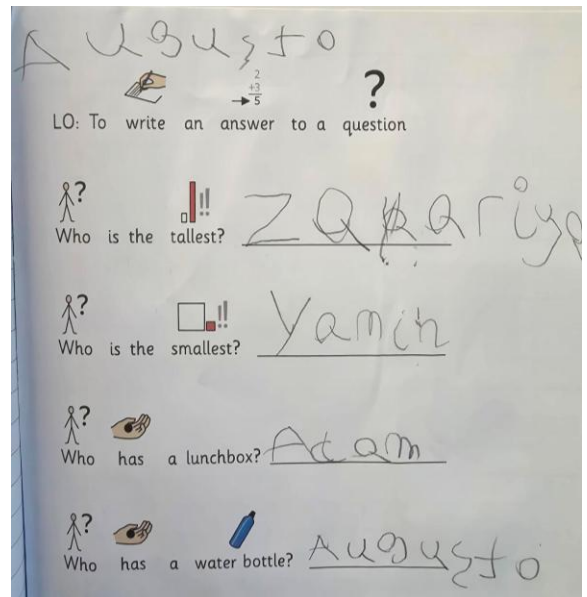
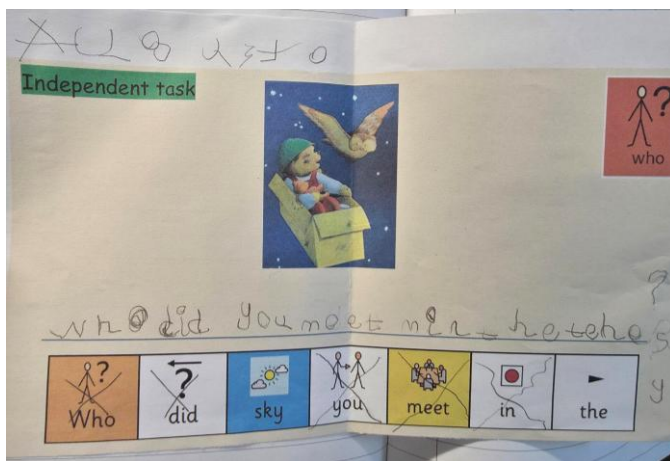
The explorers have also been incredible artists and have been mixing colours together to paint their own Jellyfish!

ARP 1 have been learning about questions and answers and practising their sentence structure.

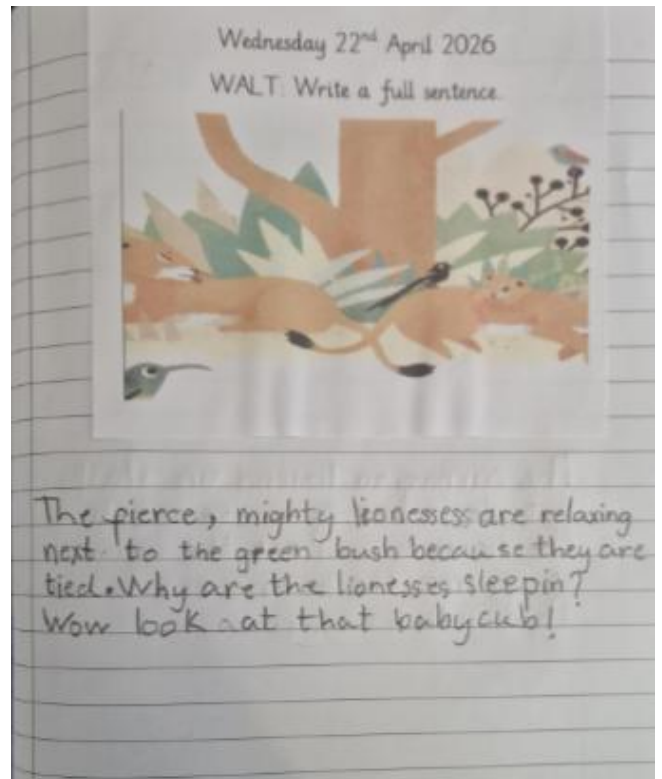
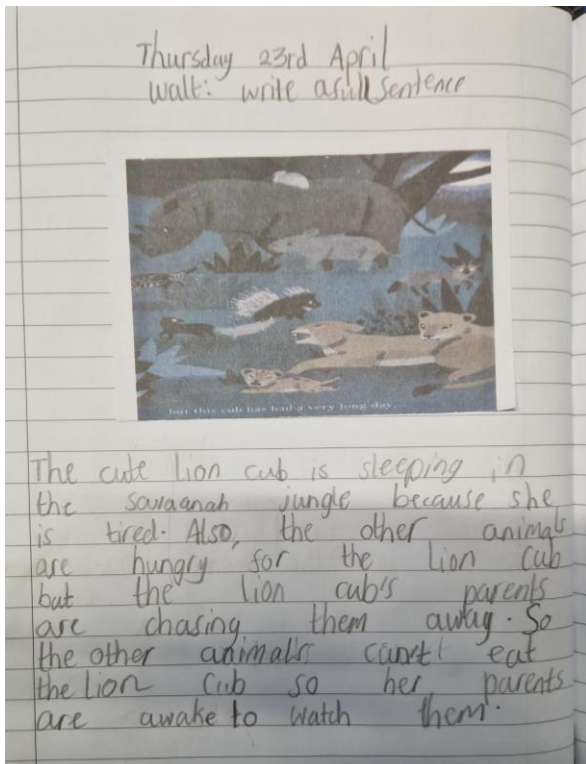


ARP 3 have been reading the book 'Here we are' to learn about the world around them. They are also solving 4-digit addition with regrouping.

## English - Year 1

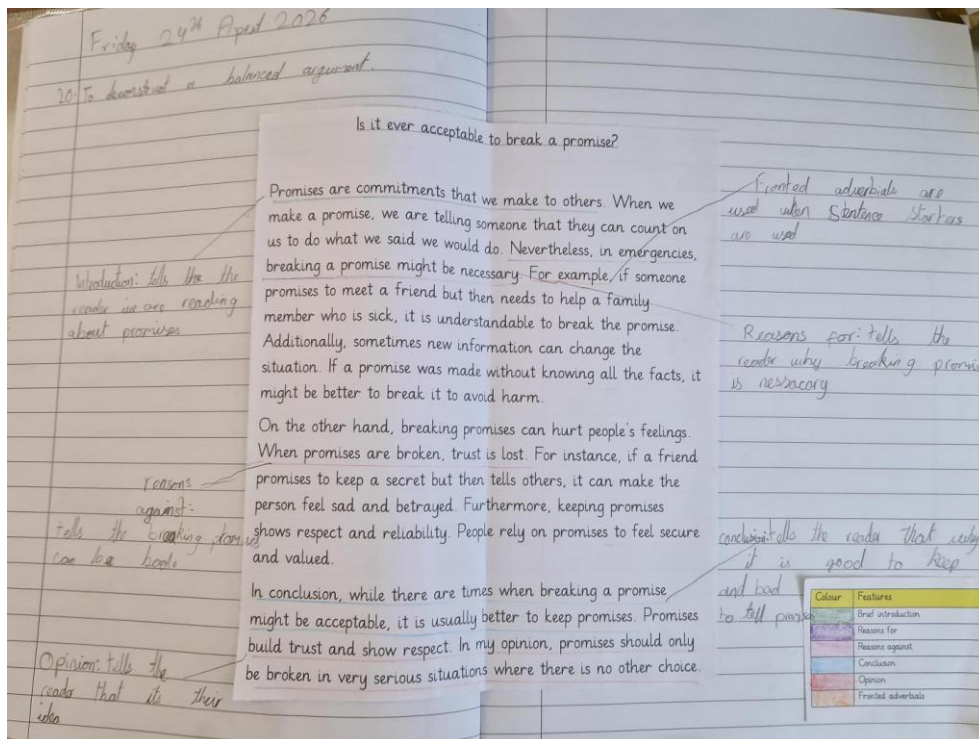
This term, Year 1 have been reading the book *One Day on Our Blue Planet: In the Savannah*. The children have been working hard on using adjectives to make their writing more descriptive and learning how to build well-structured sentences. They have enjoyed describing the landscapes of the Savannah.

The pupils have been learning how to write a balanced argument, exploring persuasive language and giving clear reasons both for and against different viewpoints. They have shown fantastic thinking skills as they consider both sides of an issue and present their ideas confidently.

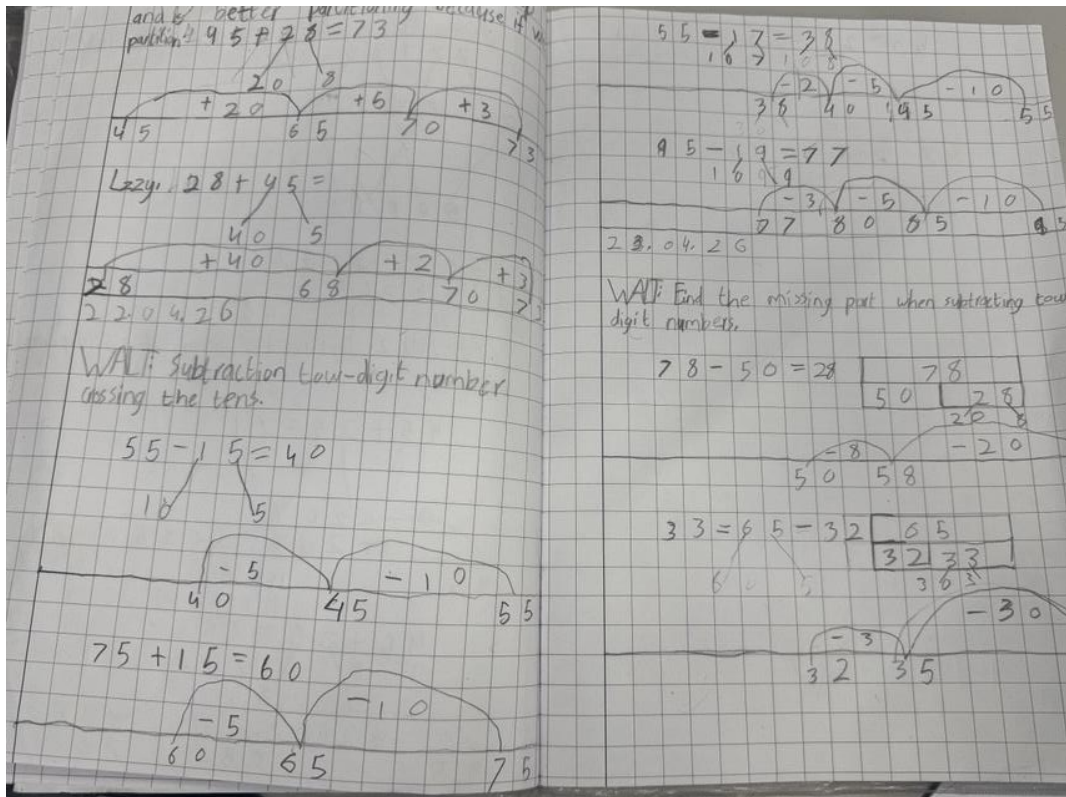

## Maths - Year 2

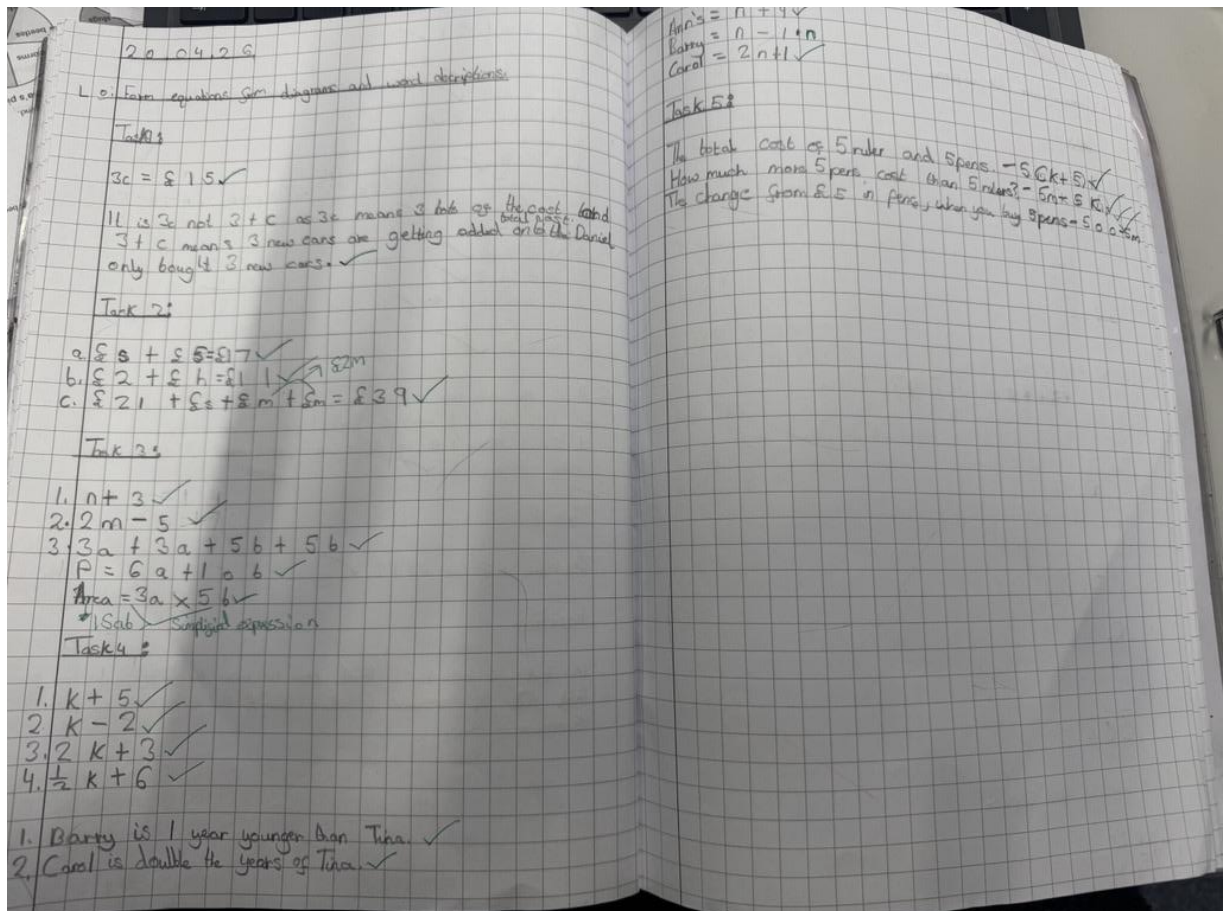
Year 2 pupils have been developing their skills in adding two-digit numbers, including calculations that cross the tens boundary. They have been using partitioning strategies, decomposing numbers into tens and ones and carefully considering how to partition one of the addends. This work builds on their strong foundation of understanding place value. Pupils also used dienes to represent numbers and demonstrate their understanding in a visual way.

## Maths - Year 6

Year 6 have been focusing on algebra. They began by exploring knows and unknowns using cubes to represent values. Year 6 then moved on to using cubes for substitution before applying their knowledge to form and solve equations from word problems.

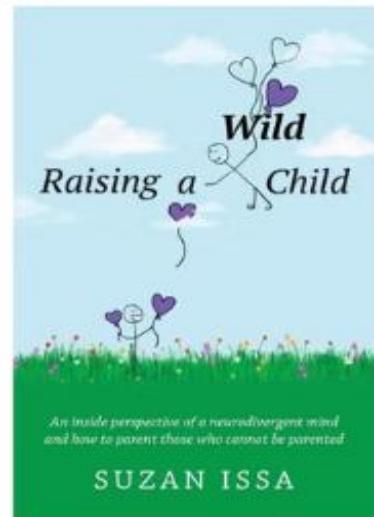

## SCREEN TIME & UNDER 5s

### What Parents Need to Know

The latest research is clear:

**More screen time = more risk.**

**Healthier habits now = better outcomes for life.**



#### The bottom line:

Too much screen time can harm your child's development, wellbeing and health.



This advice is based on the most recent evidence and guidance from Best Start in Life (UK).

### How screen time can affect your child



#### AFFECTS BRAIN DEVELOPMENT

High screen time is linked to poorer language, thinking and communication skills.

Children learn best through real-life interactions.



#### IMPACTS EMOTIONAL WELLBEING

More screen time is linked to higher risks of anxiety, low mood and behaviour difficulties.



#### DISRUPTS SLEEP

Screen time, especially before bed, can make it harder for children to fall asleep and get good quality rest.



#### LINKED TO PHYSICAL HEALTH RISKS

More screen time is linked to higher risk of overweight and obesity later in childhood.



#### CAN HARM EYESIGHT

Too much screen time may increase the risk of short-sightedness (myopia).



#### REDUCES TIME FOR WHAT MATTERS MOST

Less time for play, movement, reading, outdoor play and family time – all essential for healthy development.

### How much screen time is OK? (Recommending less is always best)

#### Under 2 years



#### No screen time.

Babies and toddlers learn and grow through real-life interaction, play and connection.



#### 2 to 5 years



#### No more than 1 hour a day.

Less is better. Choose high-quality content and watch or play together with your child.

#### Remember:

- ✓ Avoid screens 1 hour before bed.
- ✓ Keep screens out of bedrooms.
- ✓ Watch and play together. Talk about what they see.
- ✓ Be a role model – children learn from you.

#### Connect

Spend quality time talking, playing, reading and cuddling.



#### Read together

Reading every day builds language, imagination and bonding.



#### Play and explore

Encourage active, hands-on play indoors and outdoors.



#### Get outside

Fresh air, nature and movement boost mood and health.



#### Eat together

Family meals improve wellbeing and strengthen relationships.



#### Have screen-free routines

Bedtime, mealtimes and car journeys are great times to be screen-free.

We provide a Universal Speech and Language Therapy service for children under 5. We empower families and practitioners to best support their child's communication.

A child might need some support if:

They are **18 months old** or over and not yet using any words

They are **2 years old** and have less than 50 words

They are over **3 and a half years old** and it is difficult to understand what they are saying

They are **2 and a half years old** and not yet putting 2 words together e.g. 'want juice' or 'go park'.

They have been in a **new setting for 6 weeks or longer** and are still not speaking in that setting

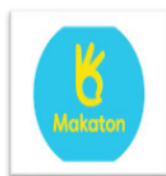


